An "A+" (20/20) project will have:

- Your name and block number
- Name and history of the disease
- A colored diagram or picture of the disease
- 12 or more facts about the disease that include signs, symptoms, body system(s) affected, how disease is spread, treatments and medicines used
- List of 2 or more ways to prevent the spread of the disease
- List of 3 references
- Equal presentation time with partner, spoke loudly and clearly for all to hear

An "A" (19/20) project will have:

- Your name and block number
- Name and history of the disease
- Diagram or picture of the disease
- 11 or less facts about the disease that include: signs, symptoms, body system(s) affected, how disease is spread, treatments and medicines used
- List of 1 way to prevent the spread of disease
- List of 3 references
- Equal presentation time with partner and spoke loudly

A "B" (17/20) project will have:

- Your name and block number
- Name and history of disease
- Diagram or picture of disease
- 10 or less facts about the disease that include: signs, symptoms, body system(s) affected, how disease is spread, treatments and medicines used
- List of less than 3 references
- Equal presentation time with partner

A "C" (15/20) project will have:

- Your name and block number
- Name and history of disease
- Diagram or picture of disease
- 7 or less facts about the disease that include: signs, symptoms, body system(s) affected, how disease is spread, treatments and medicines used
- Only 1 reference
- Less than half presentation time than partner

A "D" (13/20) project will have:

- Your name and block number
- Name of disease
- 4 or less facts about the disease
- Less than half presentation time than partner

An "F" (11/20) project will have:

- Your name
- Name of disease
- 2 or less facts about the disease
- No presentation time with partner
