## Kickoff

The ball is placed in the center of the field on the half-way line, \& the team kicking off plays the ball forward from the line. All payers from the defending team are at least 10 yates from the ball. A goal cant be scored from tia kickoff.
Fouls

Fouls \& misconduct result in a free kink to the offended win. Severe infractions result in a direct free kick; otherwise, an indirect free kick is awarded.
Some offenses for which Direct Free Kicks are awarded:

- Contacting the ball with hands or ans.
-Holding, pushing, striking, kicking, or tripping an opponent.
Some offenses for which. Indirect Free Kicks are awarded:
- A player playing the ball a ind time before it's played by another player on a kickoff, throw-in free kink, corner kick or goal kick.
- A goalkeeper carrying the ball more than 4 gteps .
-A gubstintion or re-sub. being made without reporting to the referee. - Arguing with the ff.
-Haterforing with the goalkeeper befog be releases the ball.

A penalty kick is taken from any spa: on the penalty marl. All players except kicker and goalkeeper mini be outside the penalty area.
